

Epic Enterprise Management Console

Epic's Enterprise Management Console, more commonly referred to as simply the Management Console, provides you with more graphical user interface (GUI) administration. It further simplifies the ongoing management of your system by allowing you to configure your system from GUI.

The Management Console includes workspaces that provide forms where like sets of data can be modified in an intuitive manner. Many of these forms are intended to reflect the text screens accessed through EpicCare Ambulatory and Inpatient Administration but provide the ability to open multiple records at the same time. In addition, the Management Console provides a navigational overview to guide you through the forms. The Management Console is a way for you to access multiple activities for management tasks from one central location.

Navigation

Navigation within the Management Console depends on the link you click. Clicking some of the links in the Management Console results in opening a Select a Record form, where you can choose to create a new record or open an existing one; then the record opens in a separate workspace. Several of the links in the Management Console simply provide an additional way to open an activity that can also be opened in another way. For example, the Preference List Editor can also be opened by following the path **Tools > Patient Care Tools > Preference List Editor**.

The changes you make to a record are saved when you switch to a different record or editor and when you close the record by clicking **Finish** or **Close Record** or by closing the workspace. Changes to records in the Management Console workspaces are saved much like changes to activities in EpicCare Ambulatory or Inpatient workspaces.

You can insert a row in a table in the forms available from the Management Console by pressing **F4**.

Security

If you'd like the Management Console to appear in your Home workspace, enter **MR_ADM_ROLE** as one of your user roles on the User Role Information screen of your user security record. If this role is the first one listed, the Management Console appears immediately in your Home workspace when you log in to Hyperspace. If this role is farther down in your list of user roles, you can open the Management Console in your Home workspace by clicking the **Management Console** option available from the Desktop menu.

If you've created a role for which you want the Management Console to be available, add **MR_ADM_HOME** as one of the auto-start activities for the role. If you want the Management Console to appear immediately when you log in to Hyperspace, **MR_ADM_HOME** must be the first auto-start activity listed for your primary user role.
